Application Policies

Qualifications for Graduate Admission

Candidates must possess either of the following requirements at the time of admission:

1. An undergraduate degree in any major from an accredited college or university with a good academic standing.
2. A minimum TOEFL score of 550 paper based test or 213 computer based. *Students who do not have the TOEFL test score will have to take the Stamford English Proficiency Test.*

Students from non-business backgrounds will be provided with an intensive business foundation course

Qualifications for Undergraduate Admission

To be eligible for admission into undergraduate program at STIU, the prospective student is required to possess either of the following:

1. Grade 12 or its equivalent from any accredited foreign Institution.
2. GCSE or GCE 'O' level not less than 'C' in 5 subjects.
3. Test of General Education Development (GED) no less than 'C' in 5 subjects.
4. A minimum TOEFL score of 500 paper based test or 187 computer based is required. Students without TOEFL/IELTS (5.0) need to pass the STIU English Placement test with 70% score or undergo Intensive English Language program (STEP)

Application and Payment Process

- Students have to submit the completed application form along with all required documents by email or by post. Students will be informed of their admission status only after all the documents are reviewed.
- A letter of Acceptance and invoice statement will be issued after the applicant is approved for admission.
- The application is considered complete only after the applicant makes a payment for the required fees.
- Letter of Certification is issued for VISA application process.
- Payment slip with the student's name must be sent to STIU by e-mail or Fax for the Letter of Certification to be issued.

Refund Policy

Stamford International University considers refund of tuition fee under the following circumstances:

1. **Refusal of Visa** = 100% refund (except application fee)
2. **Withdrawal after payment of fee up to registration of classes** = deduction of 30,000 Baht from amount paid.
3. **After registration and/or beginning of the term** = No Refund of Fees.

Please note that for international students who have already got a student visa from Stamford, no refund of fees will be possible under normal circumstances.
