Currency graph (JPY and USD)

The value of the Japanese Yen has **decreased** over time especially after the start of May 2018.

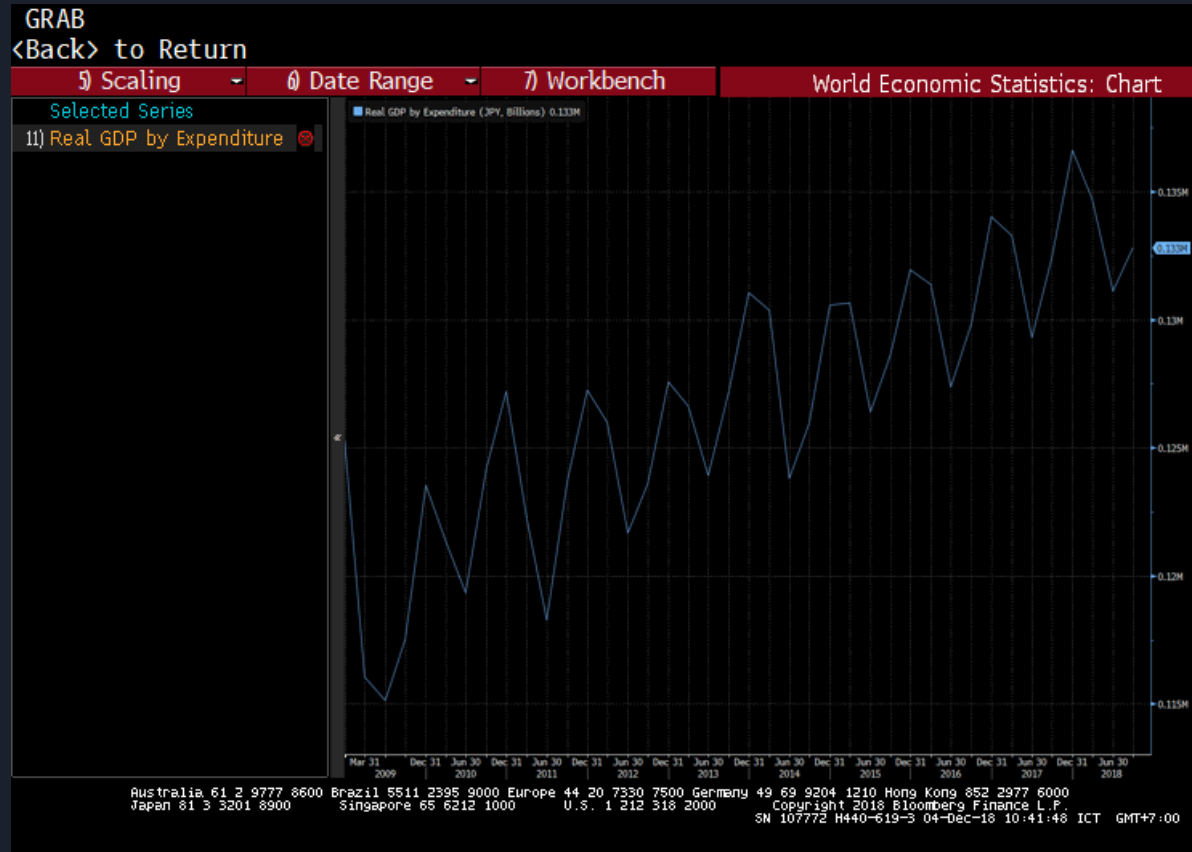
The highest value was in March 2018: **0.009547 USD**

GDP (Gross Domestic Product)

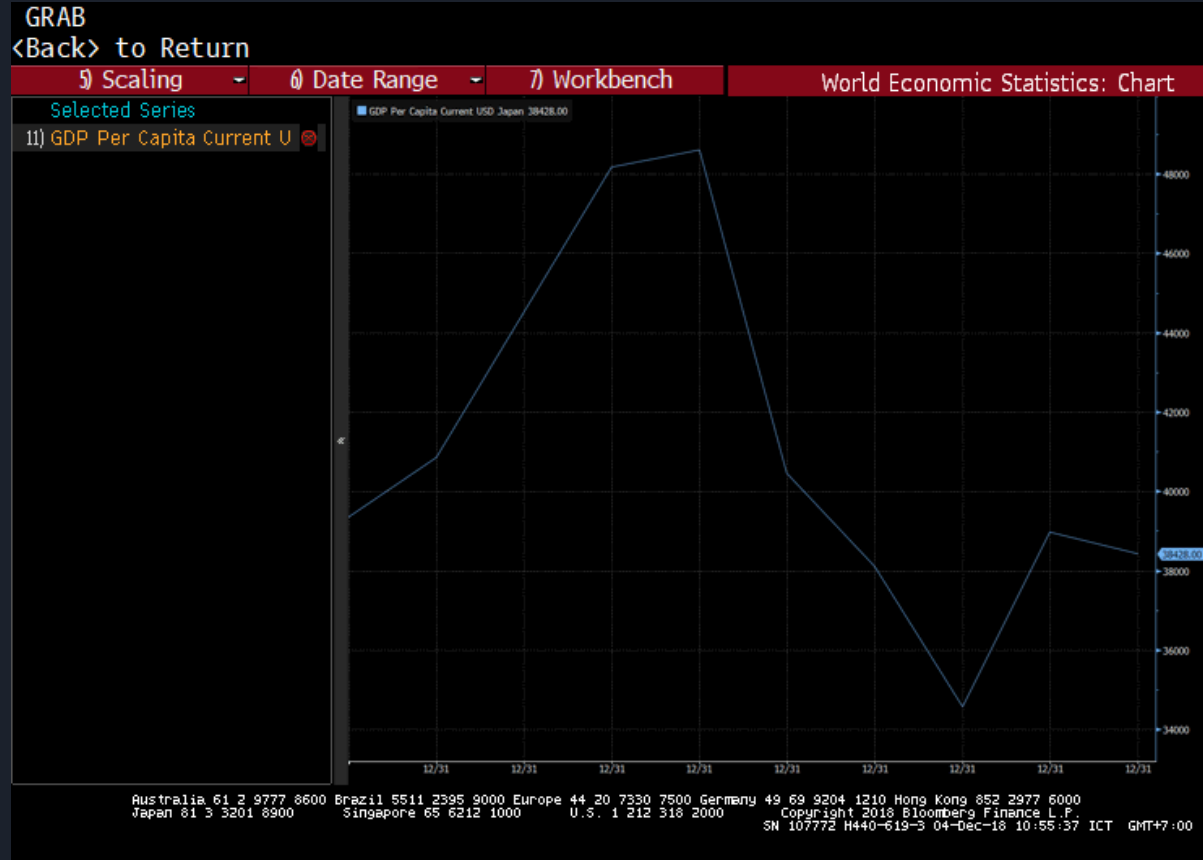
The GDP of Japan is fluctuating but overall increasing over time with the current GDP constantly going upwards.



GDP per Capita

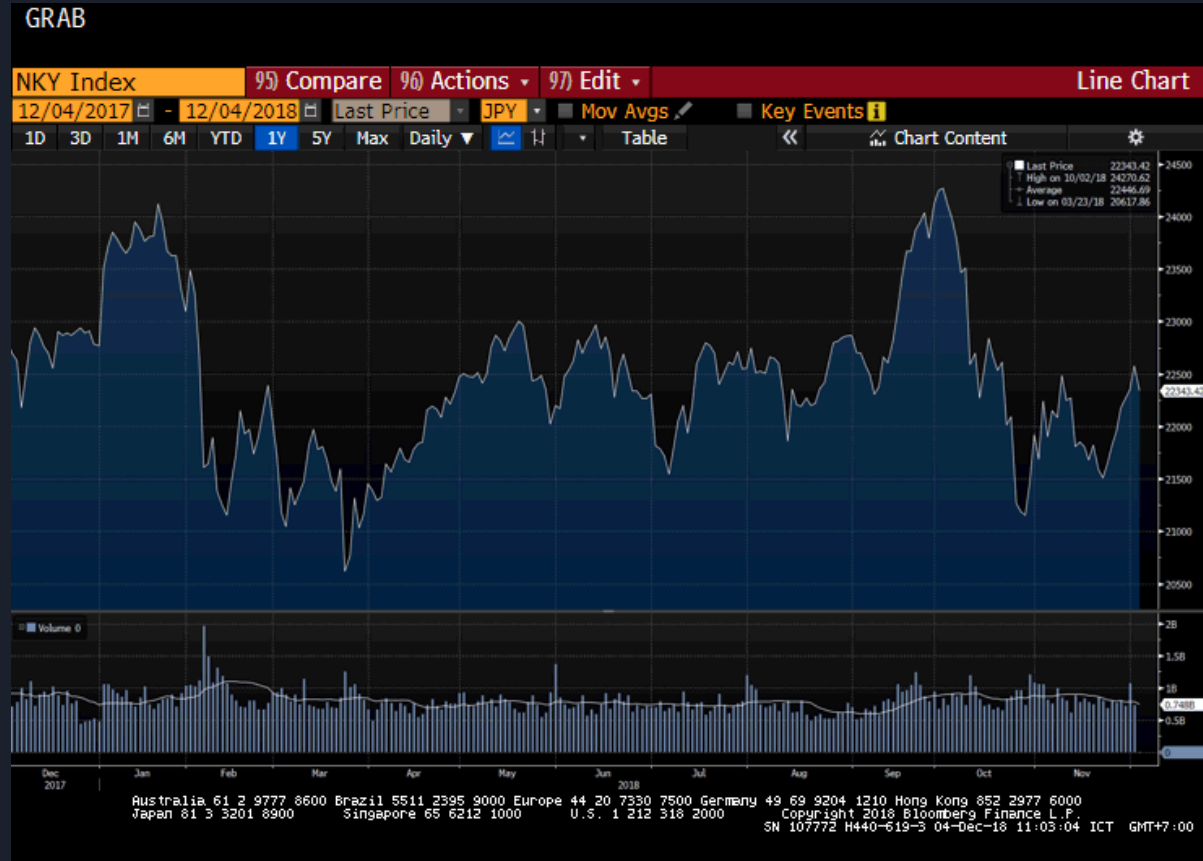
Japan's GDP per capita has decreased compared to the peak that it reached in 2012 (~48,500 USD).

The current GDP per capita is **38,428 USD**.



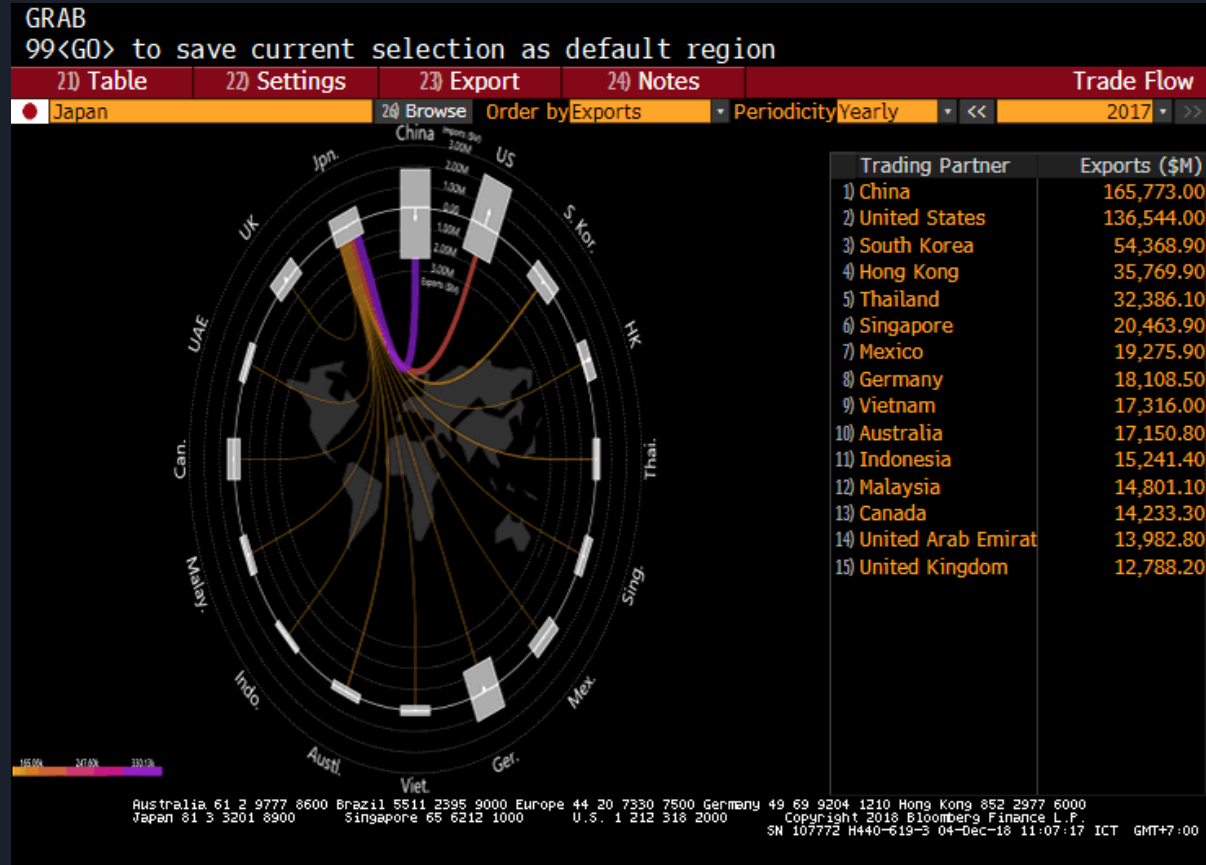
Stock Index (NIKKEI)

The stock price has **increased** from mid-November to the current price of **22,343 JPY** although it's a big difference from the high of **24,270 JPY** at the start of October.



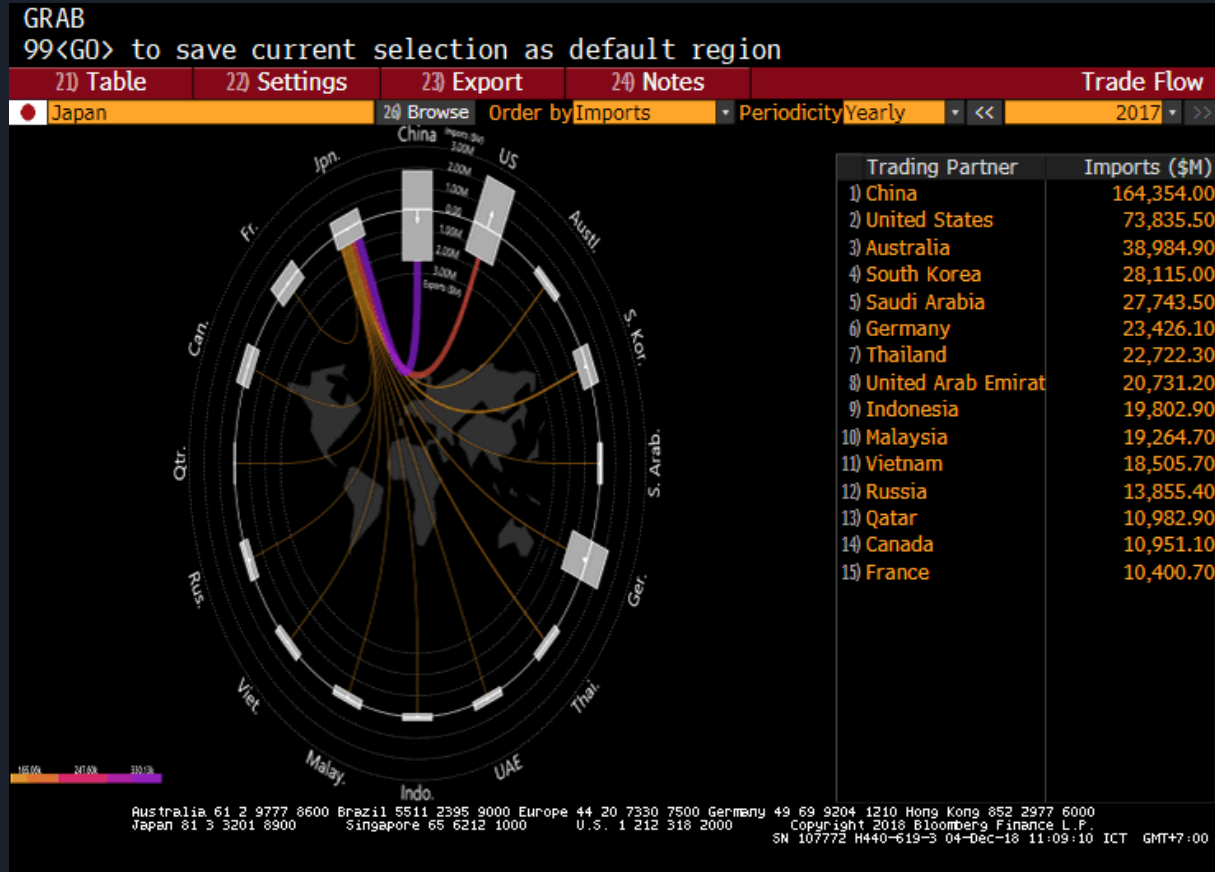
Exports
